

Use Your Citizen's Voice!

As a citizen, you have the right to contact the people who represent you in St. Paul, as well as in Washington DC.



Tips for writing to your Senators and Representatives:

- Keep your letter short and to the point. Make it one page if possible.
- Introduce yourself and explain why you're writing the letter.
- Explain how the issue(s) personally affect you and/or your family.
- When writing about a specific bill, include the bill number and a brief statement of the topic at the beginning.
- Discuss only one bill or issue per letter. Write a separate letter for each issue of concern. Letters with more than one concern are often disregarded.
- Invite the legislator to contact you to discuss the issue. Include your name, address, phone number, and e-mail address.
- Thank the legislator for considering your position and taking time to read the letter. If desired, request a reply.
- Do not send form letters.
